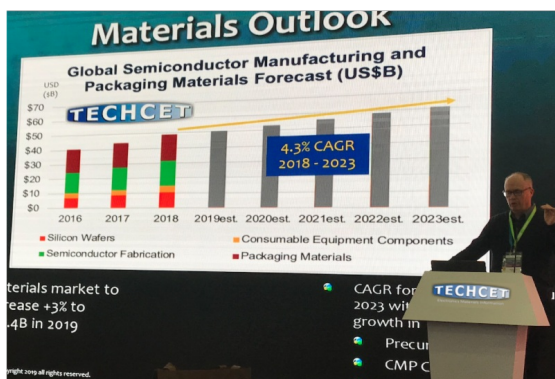




Micron VP Keynote for the 4th CMC Seminar
